Groundbreaking Ceremony

St. Charles Parish and School, the fifth largest parish in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, broke ground last week on a new concession stand area, a new vestibule and gym entrance, new restrooms, three new classrooms and a dedicated S.T.E.M. (Science Technology Engineering and Math) Lab.

The formal groundbreaking ceremony brought together nearly 285 school students – all wearing plastic yellow hard hats – along with teachers and staff, parish leaders and parishioners, Village of Hartland officials, Archdiocese of Milwaukee clergy and supporters of St. Charles to the Hartland campus. Fr. Ken blessed the ground and asked for the safety of all crews working on the project.

The \$1.8 million project is the First Phase of a major building campaign – THE CORNERSTONE PROJECT – Answering Christ's Call. Since September 2016, parishioners have pledged \$11.3 million toward a \$12 million fundraising goal.

Thank you to our parishioners for making this new construction possible with your generous pledges.

The purpose of this Rite is to celebrate their elect ion by God and the Church in preparation for the Easter Sacraments. No longer known as Catechumens, the ELECT now enter into the Period of Purification and Enlightenment which for them will be a time of more intense spiritual preparation intended to purify their minds and hearts with a deeper knowledge of Christ the Savior. As a Church community it is our responsibility and privilege to surround the elect with prayer that will accompany and lead them to encounter Christ.

The Scrutinies are celebrated in order to deliver the Elect from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ. These rites complete the conversion of the elect and deepen their resolve to hold fast to Christ and to carry out their decision to love God above all. At the March 12th, 9 am Mass we celebrate on the first of three Scrutinies and reflect on the Samaritan woman at the well, her encounter with Jesus and her conversion. Please pray for Dena, Derek, Garrett and Steve that Jesus becomes the fountain of life for which they thirst and the Master whom they seek.





If you are barely getting by financially, it is hard to decide whether you can afford to purchase toilet paper this week or to use that money to pay for gas for your car to get to work. Every day decisions like that are stressful. Thank you for assisting us to relieve some of that stress by donating financially, or by giving food, paper products, health and beauty items and more to our pantry. You help us to help others.

Prayers for the Ordination of our Auxiliary Bishops

Liturgical celebrations will mark the ordination of Most Reverend Jeffrey R. Haines and Most Reverend James T. Schuerman as Auxiliary Bishops for the Archdiocese of Milwaukee.

On Thursday, March 16 a vespers service will be held at 7 pm at St. Monica Parish, Whitefish Bay. The faithful of the archdiocese are invited to this evening of solemn prayer.

On Friday, March 17 Bishops-elect Haines and Schuerman will be ordained by Archbishop Jerome E. ListECKI in a 2 pm. Mass at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist. This is a ticketed event and not open to the general public; each parish in the archdiocese has been invited to send a representative to the ordination.



Dispensation Decree

Each year, Catholics throughout the world are expected to abstain from meat and meat products on Fridays during Lent. Once or twice a decade, we are faced with a quandary: when St. Patrick's Day falls on a Friday during this time of penance, may we eat the corned beef?

After careful consideration, Archbishop Jerome ListECKI has decided this year that Catholics in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee can take part in this tradition with a clear conscience. He has granted a dispensation which allows the consumption of meat on Friday, March 17, 2017.

Although Archbishop ListECKI has waived the rule for this St. Patrick's Day, Catholics who choose to make use of this dispensation are encouraged to engage in another sacrificial or charitable act that day.
