

**The 1% Challenge Way of Life**

*“My secret is simple: I Pray.” - St. Teresa of Calcutta*

**ASK (3 Minutes)**

- Begin in the name of the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit
- Take a moment to be still, rest and know that Jesus is here...
- Ask Jesus to help you get to know Him during this prayer time.
- Say, “Lord, teach me to pray.”

**SEEK (7 Minutes)**

- After reading the day’s scripture, take some time to reflect in silence on one or more of the following questions:
  - What word or phrases in this passage caught your attention?
  - What in this passage comforted you?
  - What in this passage challenged you?
- Re-read the passage.
- Take a few minutes to simply listen and then respond with: “I hear the Lord saying to me...”

**KNOCK (5 Minutes)**

- Based on what you hear the Lord saying to you, now ask Him what He wants you to do today or this week in light of his Will for you.
- Listen to His answer to you and then respond by saying, “I believe the Lord wants me to...”
- Ask the Lord for what you need to respond to His word. Thank Him for being with you today.
- Close with an Our Father. End in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit.





## Science Experiments Abound at St. Charles Parish School

Middle School students recently presented Science Fair Projects, detailing their interest in the topic they picked and how tests either proved or disproved their hypothesis. The subject areas were divided by grades: 6th grade focused on consumer science, 7th grade on chemistry and 8th grade on physics. The serious-minded students hit all ends of the spectrum when selecting their topics – everything from finding the best popcorn based on the number of kernels popped to determining the type of music that makes bacteria grow to designing trusses. These kids didn't take the easy way out.




